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**Modified Lammer's checklist tool for 1yo anaphylaxis case.**

No.	Skill	Critical action step	Complete action	Incomplete action	Could not observe action
1	Airway & Breathing assessment	Assess airway (ask child to speak or observe crying)			
2		Auscultate chest- recognize wheezing and respiratory distress			
3		Examine mouth/lips for edema (not present)			
4		Apply supplemental oxygen			
5		Consider or administer albuterol			
6	Recognition of Anaphylaxis	Inspects skin and notes hives			
7		Asks history of potential exposure (bee sting prior to symptom onset)			
8		Asks history of prior allergic reactions			
9		Verbalizes presence of anaphylaxis			
10	Circulation Assessment	Check pulse or attach cardiac monitor electrodes (sinus tach)			
11		Obtains blood pressure (hypotensive)			
12	Initial Anaphylaxis Therapy	Use length-based or age-based cognitive aide (e.g., tape, application, card) to estimate correct weight-based dose for 3-month-old (4-5 kg, Broselow tape grey zone).			
13		Gives appropriate dose of <b>IM epinephrine</b> as per protocol (Concentration 1:1,000 0.01 mg/kg= 0.18 mg; 0.18 mL IM) or Epi Pen Jr (0.15mg IM) or 'Check and inject' epi 0.15mg IM			
14		Reassess respiratory effort after epinephrine administration			
15	Adjunctive Anaphylaxis Therapy	Administer albuterol (2.5mg) or racemic epinephrine via nebulizer			
16		Consider or attempt IV placement			
17		Consider or administer IV bolus (20cc/kg)			
18		Consider or administer antihistamine			
19		Consider or administer steroids			
20	Medical control	Contact Medical Control if needed for initial or subsequent therapies as per protocol (may be performed at any point)
