

**INFORMATION TO PROVIDE WHEN CALLING
9-1-1 OR EMERGENCY RESPONSE TEAM**

Be ready to provide the Emergency Response Representative with the following information:

- Age of child
- Condition of child (with vital signs if appropriate)
- Your office location
 - If required, how to best access the office or if personnel will be meeting them to guide them into office
- Level of clinical staff present
- Desired transport destination
- Level of EMS provider required:
 - ALS (advanced life support – can provide medications, perform advanced procedures)
 - BLS (basic life support – provide transport, very limited interventions)
